Björn Bicker was born in 1972. He studied literature and philosophy before working at the Burgtheater in Vienna. Between 2001 and 2009 he was engaged as dramaturge at Munich's famous Kammerspiele theatre, where he co-devised the "City Projects" – highly-regarded theatre work at the interface of artistic and political practice. Bicker is dramatist (theatre and radio) and essayist and lectures in dramaturgy and writing for the stage. His book *Illegal* was published by Antje Kunstmann in 2009. He lives in Munich.
